



Trading Relations

- The relationship between the Northern Territory and Vietnam has developed over the last fifteen years through reciprocal visits by Ministers, Senior Government Officials and the private sector.
- Vietnam is one of Australia's fastest-growing trade markets in the ASEAN region
- On 1 November 2021, Australia and Vietnam launched the Australia-Vietnam Enhanced Economic Engagement Strategy (the Strategy), which supports our two countries' joint ambition of becoming top ten trading partners and doubling two-way investment
- There are three Free Trade Agreements currently in force for Vietnam:
 - ASEAN-Australia-New Zealand Free Trade Agreement (AANZFTA),
 - o Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership (CPTPP)
 - Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP)

Trade and Investment

The NT Government has identified Vietnam as a high priority market for international trade and investment.

In the 2021 - 2022 financial year

- Australian goods exported to Vietnam was valued at \$12.6 billion
- Australian services exported to Vietnam was valued at \$1.1 billion
- Australian goods imported from Vietnam was valued at \$8.1 billion
- Australian services imported from Vietnam was valued at \$0.3 billion
- The NT Goods exported mainly consisted of live animals (\$52 million) and confidential items of trade (\$47 million). For the FY2022, there a significant decrease in export of live animals compared to previous FYs. In return, the export of confidential items has significant increased, double FY2021 and FY2020
- Goods imported to the NT mainly consisted of confidential items (\$6.5 million), construction materials including pipes of iron steel, lime and cement (\$2 million)
